## **Additional Information:**

- The St Clare's Catholic School uniform should be worn with pride on all occasions, including when children are wearing the school uniform outside of school premises/hours.
- It is the collective responsibility of all (parents, students and staff) to ensure the Code of Dress requirements apply to every student.
- Students may be required to wear either academic or sports uniforms when representing the school (as advised).
- Children may need to adapt foot attire (wet weather shoes) in the case of very wet weather or if the weather remains wet for long periods of time. Children should always have shoes at school to comply with Workplace Health and Safety regulations (i.e plain black leather joggers). Students must never have bare feet inside school grounds.

## Steps in place for children wearing incorrect uniform

- 1. Parents are to notify school if their child is out of uniform, including a reasonable timeframe for when the correct uniform will be worn.
- 2. Classroom teachers will give verbal reminders to children and specifically to children out of uniform without explanation from their parents.
- 3. Children who are consistently out of uniform will have a Uniform Reminder sent to parents via COMPASS.
- 4. Parents of children who still continue to be out of uniform (after 3 COMPASS Uniform Reminders) will be contacted by the Principal or APRE with a Uniform Breach via COMPASS or phone call. A student may not be permitted to return to class until Code of Dress is followed.
