

Dear families,

RE: Term 2 Education Delivery for Catholic Education NT

The latest advice from NT Minister for Education -Selena Uibo- received on 9th April 2020 is that all NT schools will be open in Term 2 and that students are expected to attend school from day one, Term 2 – Monday, 20 April. All Schools will be delivering education as normal, in the classroom.

The priority for schools and teachers in Term 2 will be the planning and delivery of lessons to students attending school. Based on this scenario, where it is anticipated that the majority of students will be at school and lessons will be face to face, teachers will not be expected to deliver synchronous learning for students at home.

In the event that a family chooses to keep their children at home, schools will provide hard copy learning materials and in some cases online learning options for students (where possible). The attached CENT Home Learning Guidelines and protocols are attached as a guide for those students and families who choose to engage in home learning.

School decisions regarding curriculum delivery and support for students will be informed by student attendance figures, class structures and staff availability. These will be communicated directly to families.

Please contact your child's school if you have any queries in relation to curriculum delivery for your child in Term 2.
