Good Counsel College Levies

Capital Levy: charged on a per family basis and used for:

- Repaying loans for buildings and improvements
- Raising funds to enable new building works or improvements

This levy enables us to continue to improve our facilities to give our students a pleasant physical environment.

P&F Levy: charged on a per family basis and paid directly to the P&F. How these funds are spent is in the hands of our friendly Parents & Friends Association.

Resource Levy (Junior & Senior): charged on a per student basis and used for items including but not limited to:

- Purchase of resources such as iPads, sporting equipment
- Student laptops including insurance, hardware, software, maintenance and IT support
- Subject & Library Resources
- Classroom Consumables & Resources
- Printing allowance
- Lockers
- Student workbooks
- Sports carnivals
- Arts Council productions
- Compulsory Excursions, Camps & Retreats

The levy ensures you know the upfront costs of education at Good Counsel College and will not be required to pay for extra activities or items during the school year.

Vocational Education Training Levies: vary and are charged on a per student basis for Certificate courses only. This is due to the added expense of providing these courses which offer the students extra qualifications over and above their school education.

Other Charges for Voluntary Activities: vary depending on the activity and are used to recoup costs the College incurs providing or organising the activity. Examples include the travel for extracurricular sport and Canberra, Japan and China trips.

These levies are to ensure equitable distribution of school funds and create a user pays system.
