Uniform Policy

To maintain consistency of the College uniform, all items with the exception of shoes and bags must be purchased at the College Uniform Shop. Socks, hats and senior ties may be purchased at any time from the College Office.

- The full College uniform is to be worn correctly at the College, travelling between home and the College and on other occasions as required.
- Students are expected to be neat and appropriately dressed at all times and to wear their uniform with pride.
- Shoes must be hard, black full leather upper (including tongue) to meet Work Place Health and Safety requirements.
- Make-up, including nail polish, is not to be worn with the College uniform.
- Hair must be of natural colour and well groomed. Hairstyles are to be compatible with the College uniform and not of a radical style. The College administration decides the acceptability of any hairstyle. More detail can be found below.
- All items of uniform are to be clearly marked.
- Variations of the College uniform must be explained by a note signed by the parents/guardians and signed by the Year Level Pastoral Coordinator. This note must be carried at all times until the correct uniform is worn. Absence of this note will mean a 20 minute withdrawal during Morning Tea in the Responsible Thinking Classroom.
- Junior girls uniform – the top button of the shirt must be done up with the tie attached.
- Shirt sleeves are not to be rolled up.
- All senior students must wear their tie.
- The College formal uniform is worn by selected students on special occasion. This uniform is available for loan on request and must be returned clean and ironed. Please see the Uniform Convenor for more information.

Hair and Jewellery Policy – Girls

- One plain pair of sleepers, studs or small earrings may be worn in the ear lobes. A plain metal chain with a religious symbol or crucifix, medic alert and/or wristwatch is permitted.
- Hair is to be neat and tidy and should not be dyed. Hair at or below shoulder length must be tied back with a white, gold, maroon, black or clear hair tie/ribbon. Hair must be kept off the face.

Hair and Jewellery Policy – Boys

- A pair of stud/sleeper earrings may be worn in the ear lobe.
- A wrist watch or medic alert are permitted.
- Hair must be natural colour, shorter than collar length and kept off the face. Boys are not permitted to have their hair shorter than a 'number 2' cut. Boys must be clean shaven.

Junior Uniform Requirements (Years 8 to 10)

Girls:

- Blouse – maroon, grey and white check short sleeved with tie attached.
- Culottes – maroon.
- Hat – maroon wide brimmed.
- Shoes – **Black hard leather upper (traditional style) school shoes.**
- Socks – grey turn down ankle socks.
- Bag – any.

Boys:

- Shirt – maroon, grey and white check short sleeved.
- Shorts – grey College shorts.
- Hat – maroon wide brimmed.
- Shoes – **Black hard leather upper (traditional style) school shoes.**
- Socks – grey turn down ankle socks.

Unisex Winter Wear:

- Winter Zip up Jacket – maroon, grey and gold fleecy jacket.
- Winter Pants – maroon fleecy track pants.

Unisex Sports Uniform Requirement Years 8 to 12:

- Shirt – maroon, grey and gold College polo shirt.
- Shorts – maroon rugby knit shorts.
- Hat – maroon wide brimmed.
- Shoes – low sandshoes or joggers
- Socks – white socks with maroon, grey and gold stripes.

Any item that is deemed to be outside of the uniform policy will be confiscated for a period of 7 days and will require the parent/guardian to sign and collect it on the due date from the College Office.

Senior College Uniform Requirements (Years 11 and 12)

Girls:

- Blouse – white short sleeved with maroon trim.
- Skirt – grey to the knee double pleated.
- Tie – long maroon and grey striped satin tie.
- Hat – maroon wide brimmed.
- Shoes – **Black hard leather upper (traditional style) school shoes.**
- Socks – grey turn down socks or stockings of grey colour.
- Winter Blazer – maroon with College logo on pocket, **this is a mandatory item.**
- Winter Pants – grey girls College pants.
- Bag – Any.

Boys:

- Shirt – white short sleeved with maroon trim.
- Shorts – grey College shorts.
- Tie – long maroon and grey striped satin tie.
- Hat – maroon wide brimmed
- Shoes – **Black hard leather upper (traditional style) school shoes.**
- Socks – grey turn down socks.
- Winter Blazer – maroon with College logo on pocket, **this is a mandatory item.**
- Winter Pants – grey boys College pants.
- Bag – Any.

ITEMS THAT ARE UNACCEPTABLE AT THE COLLEGE

- Mobile phones, mp3's, iPods, Smartphones (see ICT policy).
- Bubble gum and chewing gum.
- Nikko pens or white corrector.
- Aerosol cans.
- Bringing cigarettes, lighters or matches, alcohol or illicit drugs to College is a most serious breach of College rules. Students may at the discretion of the Principal be suspended or expelled for serious breaches of College expectations.
- Any incident involving illicit drugs is reported to the Police. Anyone who brings cigarettes, drugs or alcohol to College is liable to be suspended or excluded.
- Knives, sharp or dangerous objects.
- Any item that may be deemed as a weapon.
