2 Agenda Items

2.1 Business Arising from Previous Meeting – Review of Action Items

Item 20220601 - Cartwright Street safety review with TMR initiated.

04/12/2024 – At 04/09/2024 TMR had informed closed this matter with committee requesting to go back to TMR to suggest double line marking.

Discussions held with all resolution options exhausted and Committee agreeing to close out.

Item 20221207 - Exelbys Siding Blind Spot

04/12/2024 - Update provided by Kevin Riseley (TMR) informing works to be completed in 2025 that RoadTek seeking funding for local projects.

Rick Butler raised another blind spot near Craven Cane Siding (Baillies Road, Upper Stone) where vegetation requires management. Council to raise works request. (reference: CR25.0004103)

Item 20230906 – Line Marking on Stone River Road intersection with Venables Crossing

04/12/2024 – Update provided by Kevin Riseley (TMR) that matter remains with Traffic Engineering for review and anticipate will bring update to next meeting.

Item 20231206 – Supplementary Signage on Bruce Highway

04/12/2024 – Update provided by Kevin Riseley (TMR) that propose southern approach sign for side road access with northern approach sign to be removed. Clearing works planned inside curve from Christies Road to Seymour Road.

Item 20231206 – Advisory signage request for “slow moving farming machinery”

04/12/2024 – Haydn Grazioli to contact TMR Corridor Management to propose Council pay and install signage.

Item 20231206 – Status of installation of signs near Parravicinis floodway and Lucinda Road

04/12/2024 – Update provided by Kevin Riseley (TMR) that works planned for 2025 with funding being sought.

3. Correspondence

3.1 Outwards Correspondence

3.1.1 Nil.

3.2 Inwards Correspondence

3.2.1 Email from Mariana Maree (Wilmar) advising at the Alma Street intersection, part of the rail crossing is obstructed when approaching the T-section. Visitors may not realise there are multiple rail crossings on road. Suggestion that moving the blue signs to the green board or further back could help improve clarity.

04/12/2024 – Wilmar to consider updating sign into new style which is more prominent. Road crosshatch suggested. Kevin Riseley (TMR) advised will inspect.

3.2.2 Flood warning sign at the Anabranh Road crossing is obstructing the vision of the right-side Wilmar crossing light:

04/12/2024 – Near miss video observed. Confirmed driver doing speed limit and orange beacon and lights viewed as working. Kevin Riseley (TMR) advised will inspect and to look at relocating TMR flood sign.

3.2.3 Customer request received from Yvonne Bosworth (Speed signs within Canegrowers Lane - She advised that she believed in the past there were speed signs for 5km/hr throughout the lane however there are currently no signs present).

04/12/2024 – Council staff found no records of 5km/hr signage and being within urban footprint 50km applies. Consensus was that cars would not be exceeding speed limit, but that pedestrians have little warning of vehicles. Council to conduct a speed limit review of area.

3.2.4 Customer request received from John Truffa (Safety issue when turning into/from Abswold Road to the Bruce Highway, Bambaroo. Requesting upgrade for turning/merging lanes to avoid near misses with vehicles that do not slowdown in time).

04/12/2024 – Kevin Riseley (TMR) advised TMR to seal road further back and sign to be moved, to follow up and provide update.

4. General Business

- 4.1. Confirmation of 2025 meeting dates – Committee committed to Wednesday 5 March, 4 June, 3 September and 3 December 2025.
- 4.2. Zenan Reinaudo – Raised Harvester Contractor complaints along Forrest Beach Road with assumption of tourists overtaking. Suggestion to add signage to 100km areas. Rick Butler raised in past contractors placed signage at Cane Sidings, which remains practice elsewhere. Zenan to take to Canegrowers to enquire if signage is a corridor permit condition. Raised as education opportunity for Canegrowers, Wilmar, Council and the Hinchinbrook Visitor Information Centre at start of season;
- 4.3. Scott Gofton – Raised that there has been a tree removed from Victoria Mill Road railway crossing intersection believed to have been completed by TMR. There are roots remaining that are blocking drain. Kevin Riseley (TMR) to follow up;
- 4.4. Frank Martino – Raised visibility concerns behind Docs Auto Clinic on Lynn to Gedge Streets Ingham. Damaged mirror impacting in addition to large hedge belonging to 25 Lynn Street. Council to raise request for Regulatory action. (Reference: CR25.0004109);
- 4.5. Kevin Riseley – Shared Eleanor and Hardy Street Ingham road counts. Traffic Engineer to review and will bring findings to next meeting;
- 4.6. Cr Carr – Eddleston Drive Cordelia speeding. Hadyn Grazioli informed that traffic count data 24/10/2024-29/11/2024 taken from Eddleston Drive 50m from Blue Butterfly Road confirming speeding occurrences. Informed potential bus stop is proposed and queries raised if bridge can handle heavy vehicles including B-Double's.
- TMR and QPS to be provided data from Council and Wilmar to review. Haydn Grazioli to have latest traffic count set up installed into original intended position; and
- 4.7. Luke Argent – Brought up flood boom gates in Halifax from Macknade and at Washaway and mention of Wallaman falls works in addition to manual installation of Enforceable Flood signage. Committee was not in favour of these options, no further action required unless Council decides to move.
