2 Agenda Items

2.1 Business Arising from Previous Meeting of 5 June 2024 – Review of Action Items

Item 20220601 - Cartwright Street safety review with TMR initiated.

04/09/2024 – Update provided by K Riseley (TMR) as follows - Concept Drawings titled Option 1 and 2 were tabled to the committee at the 06/03/2024 HRSAC Meeting and following review, both were not supported. There are no further infrastructure options from TMR and no further investigation into, or updates on this. TMR have now closed this matter.

Meeting committee request officers to go back to TMR and suggest double linemarking to prevent U-Turns in the area.

Item 20221207 - Exelbys Siding Blind Spot

04/09/2024 - No update provided from TMR. Request for officers to seek update and timeline from TMR.

Item 20230706 - Signage of Bruce Highway, Ingham

04/09/2024 – Haydn Grazioli advised that a desktop assessment of signage has been done and it is not considered to be an issue. Will continue to monitor. Matter closed.

Item 20230906 – Line Marking on Stone River Road intersection with Venables Crossing

04/09/2024 – Update provided by Kevin Riseley (TMR) as follows – Matter is currently with Design/Engineering for review.

Item 20230906 – Visibility issues from sugar cane on road verge Halifax Road, Foresthome

04/09/2024 – Early cut has been done, follow up on early cut each year. Canegrowers/Wilmar to continue to correspond at commencement of each season.

Item 20231206 – Advisory signage request for “slow moving farming machinery”

Zenan Reinaudo requested on behalf of Canegrowers members for advisory signage to notify drivers of “slow moving farm machinery” north and south on the Bruce Highway and popular tourist roads. Consider installation near Toobanna near Orient / Pomona Roads, Abswold Road, Coolbie and the southern side of Cardwell Range. Kevin Riseley will check for existing signage and give feedback.

04/09/2024 – Kevin Riseley (TMR) provided update as follows – The request to install a sign – Watch for Slow Moving Vehicles Hauling Cane (near Jones Road) is not supported by Northern District at this time. Officers to contact TMR again and give them a different perspective. Haydn suggested Council offer to put sign up with TMR permission. Haydn to discuss with TMR to put sign up.

Item 20231206 – Status of installation of signs near Parravicinis floodway and Lucinda Road

Kevin Riseley to follow up the status of installation of signs near Parravicini’s floodway on Lucinda Road and corresponding flip sign at Ferrero Road.

04/09/2024 – No update from TMR – follow up.

Item 20230906 – Supplementary Signage on Bruce Highway

Tony Iafano requested supplementary signage on Bruce Highway to advise of School Bus entering on approach to Seymour Road. Referred to Kevin Riseley at TMR to investigate.

05/06/2024 - Tony Iafano expressed his disappointment in relation to this item being closed out. The resolution refers to Seymour Road, however the issue is located on Christies Road (looking right onto the Bruce Highway) and would like the matter reopened. Committee agreed the intersection visibility is awful. Matter to be reopened.

2.2 Revision of Terms of Reference

04/09/2024 – Comments regarding the current Terms of Reference - No current SES Local Controller for Ingham appointed – leave in as someone will be appointed. Haydn – update membership to include both Hinchinbrook Bus Service and Herbert River Bus Service. Rick Butler advised he is not with Stone River Bus any longer – include him as community representative on committee.

3.2.1 Email from Brian Newman (Lannercost Street Ingham pedestrian crossing safety – Coles to Supercheap);

04/09/2024 - TMR advised they have completed enquiries – Cr Carr will contact Brian Newman to advise. Remove Item.

3.2.2 Email from Nicci Tonks (Macrossan Street Halifax speeding);

04/09/2024 - Respond to Nicci advising Council will put digital noticeboards out reminding of speed limit etc. Situation to be monitored.

Macknade speed bumps – vehicles going around speed bumps. Further education to be promoted to community.

- 3.2.3 Customer Request from Alenka Stepcic (Safety of railway crossing on Abergowrie Road just before 27 Abergowrie Road);

04/09/2024 - Suggest Canegrowers/Wilmar to action pre-season early cutting in this area and notification prior to commencement of season. Committee consider visibility is sufficient. Promote awareness and education.

- 3.2.4 Email from Kevin Riseley with TMR updates for the items listed in the minutes from the June 2024 Meeting.

4. General Business

- 4.1. Frank Martino – Seeking installation of bus shelter on pool side of Ingham State Primary School. Requesting an existing bus shelter that is no longer being used be re-located to this position. Haydn to investigate possibility – concerns regarding possible location of shelter as close to pedestrian crossing as possible;
- 4.2. Frank Martino – Accident in front of Chiesa – intersection – Haig Street/Herbert Street – visibility is dangerous – suggest closing off island turn around section of road – this would increase parking and would be safer for pedestrians. Committee consider this will potentially create issues elsewhere;
- Luke Argent to investigate possibilities of alleviating sighting concerns as part of future black spot funding. Haydn Grazioli advised that the idea of closing this section has been discussed previously and has not been favourably received. Any change would require extensive community consultation;
- 4.3. Luke Argent – Expressed thanks to Scott Gofton and the Wilmar team for prompt response in cleaning up from recent train derailment in town – all communications were great and well received;
- 4.4. Cr Carr – Residents have again raised concerns regarding motorists speeding along Eddleston Drive Cordelia – seeking more patrol cars and perhaps Council (Haydn Grazioli) to deploy traffic counters and digital signage. Suggest locating these on eastern side;
- 4.5. Rick Butler – All the new roads are not getting line marked very quickly and 80km/hr speed zones are being left for a long time;
- 4.6. Jeff Aitchison – The road from Halifax Transfer Station (Mahoney's Road) – there is a 100km/hr sign at the end of the road just before the intersection to turn towards Taylors Beach – it does not seem like it should be 100km/hr;
- 4.7. Haydn Grazioli – Council have received a Public Incident Report – near miss Beatts Road Allingham. Haydn seeking committee input – does this perhaps require linemarking, there's not enough room for bike lane, not enough area for footpath. Committee suggest the road is not wide enough to support line marking. School buses have no issues traversing that road. Perhaps just requires education – walk towards traffic not with traffic so that you can see what is coming. Haydn's team is reviewing. Luke advised there is some cycling network funding coming up;
- 4.8. Scott Gofton provided positive feedback regarding the new linemarking on Mylrea Street Ingham; and
- 4.9. Zenon Reinaudo advising that with ongoing industrial action and weather the cane season will be extended possibly to mid December.
