

School Fees payment options at Holy Spirit Catholic School





BPAY

We now have BPAY as an option for you to pay your school fees. **Please refer to your next statement to see your BPAY details.** You may setup your own weekly, fortnightly, monthly or term time payments using this option. This gives you the opportunity to stop or start payments at your own convenience.



COMPASS PAY

Make a payment any time through Compass Pay. You can do this as often as you like and this option also gives you the convenience of an accurate balance of your fees. Payment is made directly from your bank account to your school fee account. Please check with the office if you have forgotten your username or password.



PAYWAY - FORTNIGHTLY DIRECT DEBITS

Families can enter into an agreement to make a fortnightly deduction from your bank account or credit card. **PLEASE NOTE There is NO END DATE** for these deductions and the transmissions will continue all through the year until further notice is given by you to stop this deduction. Payway fortnightly deductions are processed on a Wednesday. If funds are not available through your nominated account, bank charges may be applied by your financial institution. Contact the office for further information.

CASH, EFTPOS and CREDIT CARD PAYMENTS

The usual methods of payment are also available and can be made at the school office. Credit Card payments are can also be processed over the phone.

HEALTH CARE CARD CONCESSION

If you are the holder of a Centrelink Health Care Card, Pension Card (means tested) or you have DVA GOLD (only) card, you may be entitled to a discount on your Diocesan Tuition fees. If you have a card that you think may qualify, please contact the office with a sample of your card.

MULTI SCHOOL DISCOUNT

If you have a student / students attending one of the colleges within the Townsville Catholic Education diocese you will be eligible for a MSD. Please complete the form on the website and return it to the school office to be process. (This discount does not include St Patricks College or Ignatius Park College).
