2020 Instrumental Music Program

Welcome to the Ignatius Park College Instrumental Program (IMP). The IMP has tuition available in guitar, voice, brass, woodwind, drums, percussion, strings and piano. Enrolment forms are available from Pastoral Support Office or the Instrumental Music Coordinator.

Lesson Fees

All Ignatius Park College music lessons are supplied by Private Tutors and fees are payable directly to the tutors.

- Fees are \$35.00 per ½ hour individual lessons.
- Tutors will invoice students for lessons on a term basis
Example: 7 lessons/term @ \$35.00 = \$245.00 per term

Once a student is enrolled, they are committed for the entire term. No refunds will be given.

Lesson Policy

At the beginning of each term, students will be given a lesson time for their chosen instrument. Lesson time will be emailed to parents and displayed on the music noticeboard (located outside the Drama Room). These lessons will remain the same over the course of the term. This time can only be altered in consultation with your Instrumental teacher.

Student responsibility:

- Attend all lessons as timetabled and have their Student Diary signed by the tutor. Lessons missed with no explanation will be forfeited.
- Complete all classroom work missed while attending music lessons.
- Inform the Instrumental Tutor before the scheduled lesson time if they need to be excused from a lesson due to illness or College activity. These lessons will be rescheduled to another time within the term.

If a lesson is missed due to Tutor absence this lesson will be rescheduled. Withdrawal from the program requires written notification to the Instrumental Music Coordinator before the end of the enrolled term. If no written notification of withdrawal is received, the student will remain enrolled for the following term.

New to 2020

Students enrolled in the instrumental program will be invited to participate in a performance night. These recitals will provide opportunities for the students to display and enhance their instrumental skills.
