7. GENERAL BUSINESS

7.1 Workplace Health and Safety Report

AE presented the WHS and Riskware report from January to 4th April. Report will be provided each month to show what hazards have been identified and how they have been rectified.

- The development of a Safety Intergrated Safety Management Plan is in progress.
- The deadline for Conduct Regular Inspecitions on Plant and Equipment owned by JCUSA has been extended as all items of equipment need to be identified first, as well as a maintenance schedule developed and costs associated planned for.
- Ten staff have completed the safety induction and fire induction.
- Three fire wardens have completed or refreshed training. WHS Policy has been drafted but not yet published.
- All staff required to have first aid is up to date. First Aid Kits are stocked.
- Evacuation plans are displayed in all locations Instruction manuals for equipment have been compiled and 6 safe work practices statement prepared.



- WHS inspection checklist for the officer has been completed. The checklist for the gym is in progress as standards for showers and equipment need to be researched.
- Cairns Staff will be undertaking Bullying Harassment and Discrimination conducted by JCU. Date for Townsville to be advised. All Staff and council will attend WHS fundamentals training
- 18th April WHS inspector came to check site of BBQ incident and BBQ storage shed and is now Compliant.

7.2 Uni Bar Agreement

AE advised that the agreement between the Uni Bar and JCU is finalised. SN enquired about the agreement with JCUSA and Regan (Uni Bar), KRF advised this is still in progress. An agreement was made in 2016 and one in 2017 by Teisha (Acting General Manager) but was never formalised. The Mad Cow has arranged for buses to take students into from JCU from 9pm (previously from midnight) which will affect Uni Bar trading on Fridays. Plans are in progress to potentially open the venue for trading on Saturdays.

7.3 Ratification of motions at 2nd Remuneration Committee RESOLVED:

- 1. That, instead of submitting timesheets, the Council are paid fixed honorariums; and,
- 2. That from the remaining amount left in the budget not claimed before February by Councillors, that the Council will be paid the fixed amount of 5% of their annual wage fortnightly, equalling to 10% per month.

LS asked for clarity around consultation with Council when statements are prepared and released on behalf of Council and JCUSA. KRF advised that the statement she released in regards to the Change Proposal was prepared at the last minute after a number of students has approached her for JCUSA's stance on the matter. KRF stated she had emailed Council for feedback but acknowledged there was a very short timeframe. The standard process for preparing and releasing statements would include consultation and feedback with all Council (and staff if applicable) to ensure clarity and transparency. HH advised that a number of Cairns students had been concerned that JCUSA did not release a statement in a timely manner. SN stated that JCUSA is the peak student body advocating and providing a voice for approximately 22000 JCU students. He advised that JCU is facing significant changes which need to be resolved; student feedback has been received by the VC's office and is being taken into consideration in the decision making process. HH stated concern that JCUSA was not consulted about the proposed changes but rather informed.
