send through all the required supporting documents, however alongside Peter, we have still been meeting and discussing
CAPA campaign initiatives. Also with Cherie, we have been discussing CISA campaign priorities and attending their
monthly member catch-ups.
☐ A few weeks ago, Thomas and I contacted medicine and health student clubs to understand the impact of the reduction
in parking for the carpark located between the Discovery Rise and medicine class buildings. While I did raise the issue
with DVC Students, the university has sent an email to all students confirming this massive reduction and not offering any
mitigating strategies for this vast loss of carpark spaces. I will be strongly seeking further information from JCU about this
as it's not good enough to just reduce spaces but still charge the same.
Over time, more clubs and societies have been registering to co-host JCUSA's Free Brunches Which is great. This
