Are you eligible?

- ✔ You're a health professional working in the field of medicine, nursing, allied health, or Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander health.
- ✔ You provide or intend to provide services to MMM 3-7 locations (See DoctorConnect for MMM locations: www.doctorconnect.gov.au).
- ✔ You're not employed solely by the Queensland Government, including the State Health Department

Scholarships and bursaries will be provided to health professionals in remote and rural communities where up-skilling will be a direct benefit to the community and address the community's health workforce needs.
