



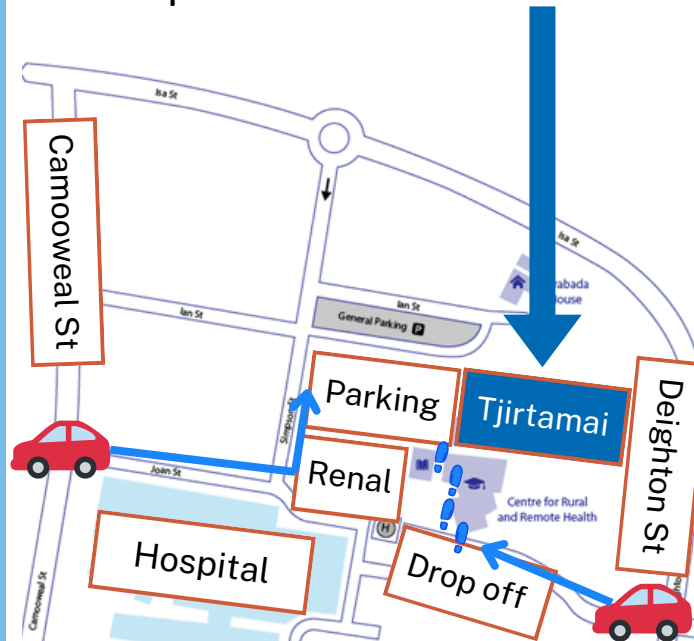

Our Services

We will listen to what matters to you, and consider:

a) Care Coordination

Connecting you with health and community services that may support your recovery.

b) Community Inclusion

Linking you to activities and resources in your community, like exercise or activity classes to help you to stay strong.

c) Therapy

One-to-one or group therapy to strengthen the skills or habits for what matters to you.
