CHANGES TO A REGISTERED PROVIDERS' OWNERSHIP OR MANAGEMENT POLICY

Purpose:

The Education Services for Overseas Students (ESOS) Act 2000 requires the college to notify the ESOS agency and other appropriate authorities of any changes to the governing body OR changes to the Principal Executive Officer of the school in accordance with Section 17A.

Policy Statement:

- 1) The Principal/International Student Officer of OLSH Catholic College must inform the designated authority in the manner and form specified by the ESOS agency for the provider of:
 - a) any prospective changes to the ownership of OLSH Catholic College as soon as practicable prior to the change taking effect; and,
 - b) any prospective or actual change to the high managerial agents of OLSH Catholic College as soon as practicable prior to the change taking effect or within 10 working days of the change taking effect where the change cannot be determined until it takes effect; and,
 - c) OLSH Catholic College will provide the designated authority with information on the new owner or high managerial agent for the purpose of making an assessment under section 7A of the ESOS Act.
- 2) The designated authorities to be notified are:
 - a) ESOS Agency;
 - b) The Department of Education Northern Territory; and,
 - c) The Australian Government Department of Education and Training.
