SENIOR STUDENTS DRIVING & PARKING POLICY

Rationale:

The parking of cars and other vehicles in and around the College grounds is a daily necessity, but also raises a number of safety and traffic issues that must be well managed.

Aim:

To ensure that car and vehicle parking in and around the College grounds is orderly, safe and in accordance with the law.

Policy:

- 1. Senior students enrolled at Our Lady of the Sacred Heart Catholic College and who have a Northern Territory Driver's Licence, can drive their car/vehicle to school and park it on College property if they meet the following conditions:
 - a) They have completed and returned an 'Application for Car Parking at Sadadeen Campus' form;
 - b) Drive responsibly to and from school;
 - c) Have their Parents/Guardians permission to drive;
 - d) Display the appropriate year's 'Driving & Parking Permit' on the dashboard of their car/vehicle while using their cars/vehicles for school purposes;
 - e) Only carry designated passengers as displayed on their 'Driving & Parking Permit';
 - f) Designated passengers have their Parents/Guardians permission to be a passenger in the driver's car/vehicle;
 - g) Agree to not accessing their car/vehicle between the time of arrival and the time of departure without the express permission of the Head of Campus or their Year Level Coordinator;
 - h) Agree to not leaving items visible in their car/vehicle so as to discourage theft; and,
 - i) Continue to hold a drivers licence.
- 2. Our Lady Of The Sacred Heart Catholic College assumes no responsibility or liability for fire, theft, damage to or loss of any vehicle or any article left therein;
- 3. If a student's 'Driving & Parking Permit' is withdrawn for whatever reason, the student's permission to park on College Property will be withdrawn. Students can still drive to school if they retain their licence, but access to parking facilities at Our Lady of the Sacred Heart Catholic College will be denied.
