CRITERIA, SCOPE AND PROCESS

Students who received a scholarship or bursary for 2022 are not eligible to apply for a scholarship or bursary for 2023.
Applicants are awarded a scholarship or bursary based on a collection of information, as follows:

ACADEMIC

- ❖ Academic performance (not necessarily academic excellence)
- ❖ Effort and cooperation

CITIZENSHIP

- ❖ Contribution to life at OLSH
- ❖ Christian Ethos / Good Character
- ❖ Role model
- ❖ Attendance record

PROCESS of SELECTION

1. Campus executives (Traeger and Sadadeen) are asked to rank the applications from their campus.
2. Each member of the College Advisory Board Scholarships Committee is asked to rank the applications.
3. The Advisory Board Scholarships Committee assesses the applications by considering their own ranking and that done by the Campus Executives.
4. The Advisory Board Scholarship Committee makes its recommendations to the College Advisory Board, which then awards the scholarship/bursaries. These are announced at Presentation Night at the end of the year. (Any member of the Board who has a child applying for a scholarship/bursary is excluded from the selection process)
