Conditions of Permit:

1. The work method statement and risk assessment provided to POTL with this application for this operation is implemented, subject to any modified methods required by the following conditions.
2. The work method statement must specify the Zone Classification and the flammable liquids characteristics, as assessed and certified, for the operation on berth 1.
3. The work method statement is to include details of the vehicle to be used on the berth with stated confirmation that the vehicle meets the specific berth zone classification relevant to the flammable liquids characteristics at the berth.
4. No cargo operations are to be undertaken while the vehicle is on the berth, with all cargo lines disconnected prior to movement of the vehicle onto the berth.
5. The vehicle to be used must be the vehicle that the statement of compliance was issued for.
6. The vehicle must only enter the relevant hazardous zone the machine is certified to operate within.
7. The operators/supervisor is to advise the POTL MSG at Berth 1 once lines are disconnected and they are preparing to move the vehicle on the berth.
8. The permit holder by using a vehicle on Berth 1 under this permit agrees to indemnify and keep indemnified POTL and all person claiming under POTL from and against all costs, expenses, claims, actions, judgements and /or damages which POTL may sustain, incur or become liable for in respect of any loss, damage and or injury caused the permit holder using a vehicle on Berth 1.
9. POTL reserves its right to modify the conditions of, or withdraw, this consent at its discretion should you fail to comply with the conditions of this permit.

In accordance with clause 6.4 of POTL's Port Notices a permit is required to take a vehicle on Berth 1 while a tanker is moored at the wharf.

Failure to obtain a permit for such works may result in a fine of 100 penalty units being imposed on the responsible organisation. Additionally, failure to comply with any or all conditions of the permit will result in a fine of 50 penalty units for each non-compliance incident.
