- The Berthage charge is calculated on length overall (LOA) of the vessel, subject to a minimum charge calculated on 75% of the length of berth occupied. The LOA will be determined on the basis that part of a metre is deemed to be one full metre and measurement from the tip of the stern to the most extended point of the bow of the vessel. This will include bow sprits, davits and any extruding platforms.
- Vessels greater than 35 metres LOA Price on Application.
- The Berthage Monthly Rate applies to Vessels approved to occupy a berth for periods in excess of one calendar month, with
  charges payable monthly in advance and includes berths occupied under long term Commercial Berth Agreements which
  provide for Berth Charges to be determined on review in accordance with the Schedule of Charges.
- Passenger Levies apply in addition to Berthage.



- The Master or Agent must lodge the manifest when transhipping, discharging or unloading cargo, within 24 hours of the ship berthing and when loading cargo, within 24 hours of the ship departing.
- Transshipment is to be regarded as a discharge of cargo followed by a loading of that same cargo either ashore or directly to another vessel.
- Harbour Dues at the above rates are payable in respect of all goods discharged at or shipped from or transhipped or carried at Thursday Island/Horn Island.
- Harbour Dues apply to both Import and Export for all cargo at wharves in the port, irrespective of control or ownership, and for all Transhipment.
- Where goods are imported and subsequently exported, a charge for both Import and Export is payable.
