Small business tariffs

Small businesses tariffs are designed to meet the unique energy needs of our small business customers. Customers have the option to switch between large business tariffs once in a 12 month period.

General supply tariffs

On a general supply tariff, you pay for the electricity you use at a flat rate throughout the day and night, plus a daily supply/service charge.

Tariff 20 Small Business flat-rate primary tariff

This tariff is the most common tariff for small businesses, providing a continuous supply of electricity day and night at a flat rate, plus a daily supply charge. It's suitable for small businesses that use most of their electricity during the daytime.

Demand tariffs

On a demand tariff, you're charged for the total amount of electricity you use plus a demand charge and a daily supply charge.

The demand charge is based on measuring the maximum amount of electricity you use at any point during your billing period.

When you choose a demand tariff, your whole business must be connected to that tariff.

Tariff 22 (Small and Large) Obsolete business time-of-use primary tariff

During the peak period between 7am and 9pm on weekdays, Tariff 22 is priced higher than in the off-peak period. It's generally better suited to businesses with a good proportion of night and weekend electricity usage.

This tariff is not available to new customers.

This tariff was made obsolete from 01 July 2019 and scheduled phase-out date is 1 July 2021 pending Queensland Government Gazette updates.

Large business tariffs

Large businesses tariffs are designed to meet the unique energy needs of our large business customers, using more than 100MWh per year. Customers have the option to switch between large business tariffs once in a 12 month period.

Demand tariffs

Most large business tariffs are demand-based. On a demand tariff, you're charged for the total amount of electricity you use plus a demand charge and a daily supply charge.

The demand charge is based on measuring the maximum amount of electricity you use at any point during your billing period.

When you choose a demand tariff, your whole business must be connected to that tariff.

Tariff 44 Large business monthly demand primary tariff

This tariff has a charge for the total amount of electricity used plus a demand charge for the relevant billing period and a daily supply charge.

The demand threshold under this tariff is 30kW/35kVA.

The demand threshold under this tariff is 400kW/450kVA.

Tariff 20 (Large) Obsolete large business flat-rate primary tariff

This tariff provides a continuous supply of electricity day and night, and is suitable for businesses that use most of their electricity during the daytime plus a daily supply charge.

This tariff is not available to new customers. **This tariff was made obsolete from 01 July 2012 and scheduled to phase-out on 1 July 2021 pending Queensland Government Gazette updates.**

Tariff 47 Obsolete business time-of-use primary tariff

This high voltage tariff has a charge for the total amount of electricity used (kWh), plus a demand charge (kW) for the relevant billing period and a supply charge. The demand threshold under this tariff is 400kW.

This tariff is not available to new customers. **This tariff was made obsolete from 01 July 2017 and scheduled to phase-out 1 July 2022 pending Queensland Government Gazette updates.**

Tariff 48 Obsolete large business high voltage monthly demand primary tariff only for customers classified as CAC or ICC

This high-voltage tariff is for Connection Asset Customers with usage generally more than 4GWh per year and Individually Calculated Customers with usage generally more than 40GWh per year.

The demand threshold under this tariff is 400kW.

This tariff is not available to new customers.

This tariff was made obsolete from 01 July 2017 and scheduled to phase-out on 1 July 2022 pending Queensland Government Gazette updates.
