

TERMS AND CONDITIONS GOLDEN FOOD TRUCK 2026 V1 APRIL 2026

1. The competition begins in 2026 and ends when the Gold Food Truck is found.
2. The initial prize for finding the Golden Food Truck is \$10,000 worth of gold based on the gold market rate as of April 2026.
3. From date of start 2026, the total prize value will decrease by \$1000 each month until the Gold Food Truck is found.
4. The Gold Food Truck will be cleverly hidden somewhere in Townsville. It will be placed in a public location that is accessible 24/7. No destructive actions or digging are necessary to find it. Let's keep it fun and respectful.
5. The competition organisers will not disclose the exact location of the Gold Food Truck, but monthly clues will be released. The first clue will be made available exclusively at Cotters Market, with subsequent clues being released on the first Sunday of the month. Additional clues may be released at PUFT pop-up events and through PUFT social media outlets.
6. Participants must be 18 years or older to enter the competition.
7. Participants must not cause any damage to public or private property while searching for the Gold Food Truck.
8. The first person to find the Gold Food Truck and present it to the PUFT Events team will be declared the winner. The truck will contain a QR code on its base, which must be scanned to reveal a code word. The physical truck must also be presented to claim the prize.
9. The winner may choose between receiving the remaining value in Gold bullion or a cash equivalent.
