2026 INTERNATIONAL STUDENT FEES

Our College offers CRICOS courses to boys from Years 7-12 for international students studying in Australia on a Student Visa (subclass 500). All international students must reside at St Augustine's College as full-time boarders.

An Enrolment Application form and a non-refundable fee of \$200.00 is payable when an International Student applies to study at the College.

If an offer for enrolment is granted, a further non-refundable acceptance fee of \$200 is payable, along with a Boarding Bond of \$500. The Boarding Bond is refundable upon the student's exit, subject to sufficient notice of exiting being provided and also resources returned.

Tuition fees and levies are in two-year groupings:

Junior Secondary – Year 7 to 10 Course No: 082949A

Senior Secondary – Year 11 & 12 Course No: 004918K

Fees are paid by semester and must be paid prior to the commencement of a semester* of study. Failure to pay fees prior to the commencement of the semester results in the cancellation of the Confirmation of Enrolment (CoE).

***Study period** – a study period is a Semester of study. A Term is half a study period - there are two Terms in a Semester and two Semesters in a school year.

SEMESTER PRE-PAYMENT AMOUNTS

The first Semester Pre-Payment amount must be paid in advance after a Letter of Offer is received and the International Student Written Agreement Form is signed. A Confirmation of Enrolment (CoE) can then be issued to the applicant.

TUITION FEES AND LEVIES

Tuition fees and levies are collected and accounted for separately. Tuition fees and levies are reviewed annually and increase each year. Tuition Fees must be paid prior to the commencement of the semester. Please refer to the Payment and Refund Policy.

Additional costs not included in Tuition Fees are listed in the following Schedule of Non-Tuition Expenses and Schedule of Optional Expenses.

NON-TUITION FEES AND LEVIES

International Students enrolled as Full Fee-Paying Overseas Students will incur some additional expenses, both compulsory and voluntary. These costs will be charged to your student fee account as required each term. Please find below a list of approximate costs for the following additional expenses.

SCHEDULE OF OPTIONAL EXPENSES

Wednesday Sport Program

Each Wednesday afternoon is set aside for inter-school and internal sport. St Augustine's teams compete each week against other schools in an inter-school competition. Students not involved in representative sport have a wide choice of sport and recreation activities. Costs for Wednesday sport range from free to \$150 per term depending upon the student's choice of sport.

Instrumental Music Program

Individual Music tuition fees are available at the College. Visiting instrumental teachers not employed by the College will invoice parents privately. All bands and choirs are at no extra cost to the parent. College Band uniforms are an additional cost of approximately \$100.

College Tours

National and international College tours are arranged either annually or bi-annually. These are voluntary optional expenses.

Overseas Students Health Cover (OSHC)	In Australia, student visa applicants must have Overseas Students Health Cover (OSHC) for the term of their student visa. This can be purchased from a number of health funds and must be arranged by the student before they apply for a student visa. Proof of health cover needs to be provided to the College. Stationery Costs Years 7 to 12	For students in Years 7 to Years 12, stationery can be purchased independently or from Harleys Educational store or Officeworks, in Cairns.	Stationery packs vary in costs from \$75 - \$250, depending on each student's year group and chosen electives.
Excursions	These may include visiting speakers, performances, Community Day and Arts Council etc. This excludes costs for specialised excursions for an elective.	Allow up to \$100 per student per year.
Uniforms and College Backpack	These costs are an additional expense and are not included in the fees. We recommend that each student should have at least four (4) formal and one sport uniform.
