## VOCATIONAL EDUCATION & TRAINING

ST BRENDAN'S COLLEGE

The academic program caters to a wide variety of interests and careers. There is a significant **VOCATIONAL EDUCATION AND TRAINING (VET)** course suite, a dedicated **TRADE TRAINING CENTRE, AGRICULTURAL FACILITIES AND YARDS, AND CAFÉ** onsite to support student learning and development.

**THE FOLLOWING VET COURSES ARE CURRENTLY OFFERED ALONGSIDE A SIGNIFICANT ACADEMIC PROGRAM FOR SENIOR STUDENTS:**

### CERTIFICATE II CONSTRUCTION CPC20220

This course is tailored for students seeking employment opportunities in the building and construction industry. Alternatively, it can be pursued by students interested in acquiring home handyman skills and gaining experience in using relevant tools and materials. The learning experiences are delivered through a blend of real workshop and site activities, covering areas such as wall framing, plastering, and concreting. The course also incorporates theoretical components and focuses on employability skills, including planning and organising work, workplace communication, and reading and interpreting plans.

### CERTIFICATE II AUTOMOTIVE VOCATIONAL PREPARATION AUR20720

This course is ideal for students seeking to acquire fundamental mechanical skills or those aspiring to enter the automotive or diesel fields. Students gain practical experience and develop skills through projects in simulated workplace situations. This includes identifying automotive electrical and mechanical systems and components, utilising and maintaining tools and equipment, and having the opportunity to perform basic vehicle servicing operations.

### CERTIFICATE II ENGINEERING PATHWAYS MEM20422

## **CERTIFICATE II TOURISM**

Tourism is a rapidly growing industry with applications in nearly every town worldwide. For students passionate about travel and adventure, this course serves as the first step towards a rewarding career. Participants will acquire universal skills such as coffee making and alcohol service, along with crucial abilities in customer interaction and delivering information about events, activities, and travel. The course opens doors to potential employment at visitor information centers, cultural hubs, tourism businesses, or cultural and heritage sites. Additionally, students will complete the Responsible Service of Alcohol (RSA) certification.

## **CERTIFICATE III IN AVIATION – REMOTE**

AV130419

This qualification prepares students for the role of a licensed drone pilot, providing the necessary skills, knowledge, and licenses to operate commercially. Opportunities may arise in private businesses, corporate settings, or within various government departments utilizing drones. The course serves as an excellent entry point into the aviation industry, as students cover subjects identical to those learned by pilots of manned aircraft in airlines and the military. Offering a blend of theory and practical flying, the course equips students with the skills and knowledge needed to be employed as a drone pilot in a full-time or part-time capacity.

## **DUAL CERTIFICATE II IN SPORT COACHING & CERTIFICATE III IN FITNESS**

SIS20321 & SIS30321

This course has been developed in response to the rapid growth of employment opportunities in the fitness industry. It is designed for those who aspire to work as fitness instructors or transition into personal training. The curriculum encompasses subjects such as anatomy and physiology, nutrition, screening and fitness appraisals, exercise programming, equipment use and maintenance, along with client service, risk analysis, and first aid.

## **CERTIFICATE II ELECTROTECHNOLOGY**

Once completed students undertaking this course will have gained theory knowledge and practical experience in a hands-on training environment.

## **CERTIFICATE II RURAL OPERATIONS**

AHC21216

It is also designed to enhance employment opportunities or assist in preparation for further studies at an agricultural college or the achievement of higher-level certificates, leading to employment in the fields of agriculture, parks and gardens, National Parks, and the rural sector.
