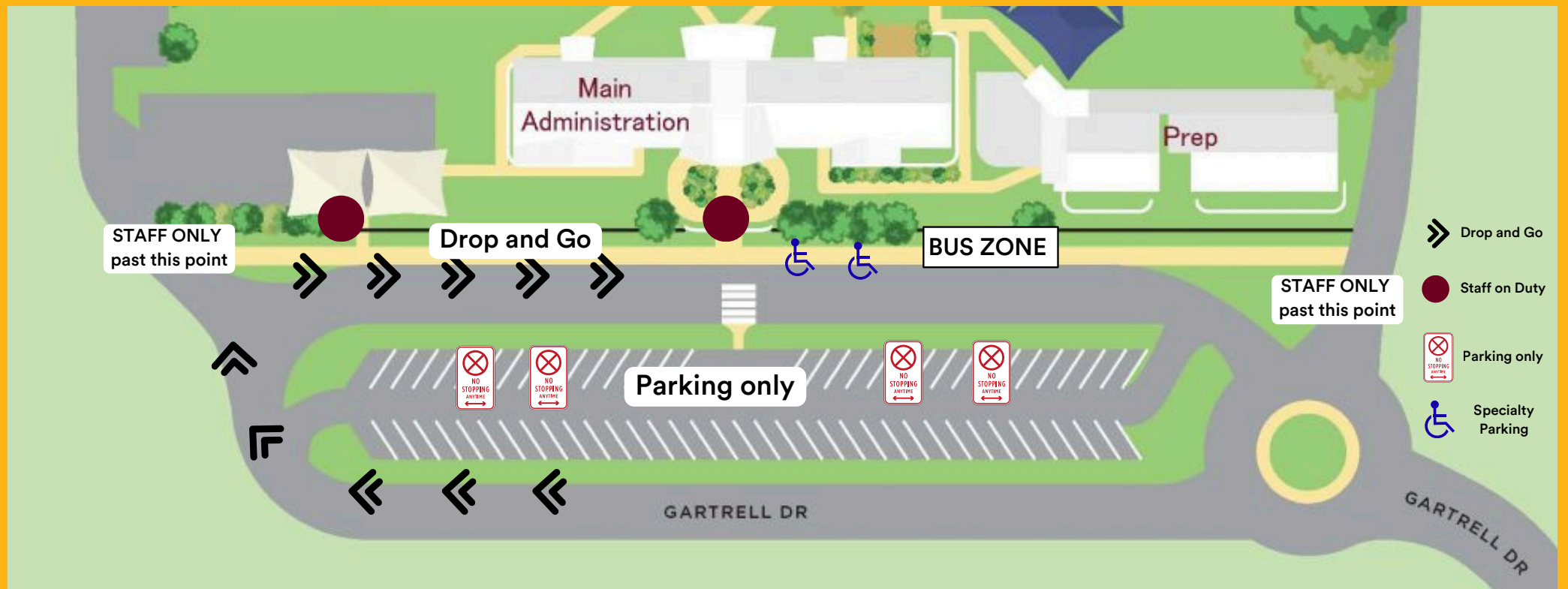

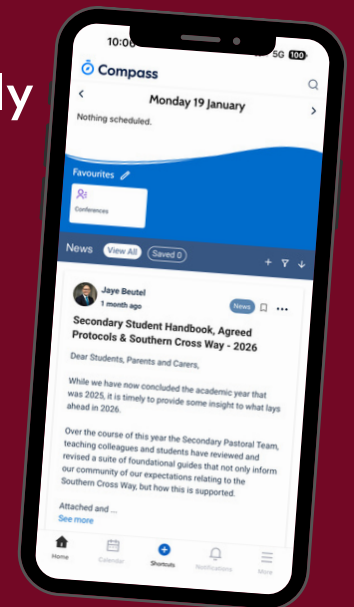


Severe Weather Alerts

During severe weather and other emergencies, the College receives guidance and advice from **Townsville Catholic Education** and Education Queensland.

We use Facebook to provide updates to our families in real time and updates are also sent through Compass as an email. In some instances, the College will send a text message directly to families.

Ensure your details are up to date in the Compass App and stay tuned to our social channels in the event of severe weather and other emergencies.





Wet Weather Uniforms

Students may wear wet weather shoes to and from school when the weather is wet.

- ✓ Crocs
- ✓ Gumboots
- ✗ Thongs
- ✗ Bare feet

Regular school shoes will need to be worn, once you have arrived at school.

Crocs and gumboots are not permitted as an all day footwear.

Umbrellas and raincoats are encouraged- Ensure all items are labelled

Wet Weather Collection

In instances of severe weather conditions such as storms and very heavy rain at the conclusion of the school day, the College may decide to keep students in classrooms until it is safe to release them into your care.

Primary students will remain in classrooms, and secondary students will either shelter in place in a classroom, or be moved to the College Hall. All students will be supervised by College staff.

For safety reasons, any changes to routine arrangements due to severe weather will be communicated directly to parents and carers.

Parents and Caregivers are also reminded that you must present at the front administration office when collecting your student early - students will not be called out of class, until you arrive and sign them out.

Getting to School Safely

Our College has dedicated Crossing Guards to assist with the safe transit from carpark to breezeway.

Parents are reminded that our carpark is a very busy area and children are unpredictable! We appreciate your help in keeping our students safe.

Students are reminded to be courteous when sharing footpaths, to have phones away and be mindful of crossings and cars.



e-Scooter Safety Information

e-Scooters are to be stored ONLY in the Primary Bike Storage enclosure - located near the front entrance.

This is the only authorised place for e-scooters to be stored during the day and the College reminds riders that this area is uncovered and exposed to the weather. Families are encouraged to stay up to date with current QLD e-scooter laws and regulations.

Scooters are not permitted to be charged at school, so keep this in mind before you leave in the morning.

Before & After School **Supervision**

Teacher supervision at the College begins at 8:00am

Supervision is provided until 3:15 pm at the Primary bike area and the Bridge Carpark.

Bus students are escorted to the bus stop by the Staff member on duty.

Any Primary students remaining at the bike area after 3:15pm are taken back to the Breezeway and must wait in a safe and respectful manner.
