Friends of Music - Instrumental Music Coordinator's Report

1. I have begun as Instrumental Music Coordinator as of term 3- part time. I started at Southern Cross term 1 2019 as wind/brass/percussion tutor, returning from mat leave. I've come from Ryan Catholic College/other schools/arts organisations. Happy to answer any questions: kprideaux1@sctsv.catholic.edu.au
2. Week 2 term 3 Mulkadee was a success. 57 students from SCCC participated in music workshops (band, choir, guitar and strings). SCCC was also represented in dance and drama.
3. Eisteddfod is week 9-10. Due to extensive damage to the Civic theatre in 2019 floods, there are no large ensemble sections. Small ensembles are being accommodated at alternate locations. We are in the process of confirming a performance opportunity for those who are missing out.
4. SHEP certificates for the Middle School SHEP program are being distributed at primary/secondary parades.
5. Semester 1 2019 was the final time Instrumental music reports were included in semester report cards. The IM program is moving to a year round feedback system through the implementation of SCCC IM achievement levels. Example over page. Current levels: 0.5-3. Students outside this range are receiving individualised plans.
6. To help implement the new IM levels, I am running weekly theory/aural assistance during 2nd break Mondays. Attendance is optional and open to all IM students needing help outside of their lesson time. There are also theory work books being finalised specifically designed for the SCCC IM levels.
7. AMEB exam session 9 is approaching: 17 August to 15 September. There are at least 20-30 SCCC IM students enrolled to participate.
