#### **BURSARY APPLICATION**

Dear Parent/Guardian,

St Mary's Catholic College is offering Instrumental Music Bursaries on voice and all orchestral instruments to students in years 7-11. The bursary will cover your child's instrumental tuition and rental for the duration of one year. These bursaries are a high honour and are only given to students who are courteous, hardworking and committed to the St Mary's Music Program.

There are a limited number of bursaries available and the places are highly contested. Bursary recipients are expected to be an example for other St Mary's Catholic College students and for the community as a whole. Bursaries run for the duration of one year and students are encouraged to re-apply for a new bursary at the conclusion of each year. Bursary renewal applications are available from the Instrumental Music Department.

### **TERMS & CONDITIONS OF BURSARY**

Students will receive lessons on a yearly basis. Students must be attending St Mary's Catholic College, in Years 7, 8, 9 or 10 and enrolled in a classroom music subject. On recommendation of the Teacher, the student will be expected to join at least one school ensemble. There is a bursary levy that you will be expected to pay totalling \$60.00 per term.

If there is a cause to reassess the bursary during the school year, they will be reviewed subject to the following criteria:

- 1. Student practises courteous and respectful behaviour in all aspects of their studies
- 2. Enrolment in classroom music
- 3. Commitment to music lessons (80% lesson attendance)
- 4. Commitment to ensemble (if applicable) with 80% attendance
- 5. Reasonable advancement on instrument indicating regular home practice

Students are required to sign and return the commitment agreement, which outlines their obligations.



## **BURSARY APPLICATION (CONTINUED)**

If the conditions above are not satisfactorily met, the bursary will be revoked. Students will be welcome to continue participating in the program as full paying students. The review will be conducted by the student's Teacher, the Instrumental Music Coordinator, and the classroom Teacher (if applicable).

On receipt of your application form we will advise you of the outcome of your application.
