DANCE BURSARY (YEAR 10) SELECTION CRITERIA

Dance bursaries are awarded at Townsville Grammar School to students who possess a passion for dance and display exceptional dancing talent. A willingness to commit to the ongoing participation in the School's Cultural program is essential.

For audition purposes the candidate will be required to:

- a) Prepare two contrasting pieces of dance to demonstrate their level of achievement (1 minute per style). For example: Contemporary and Musical Theatre. The level of difficulty must conform to the level of dance which is currently being studied.
- b) Demonstrate an understanding of the creative, choreographic concepts of dance in a theoretical sense, as demonstrated in PART C of the application form. The student will have the opportunity to explain their idea and give a short example of their described movements during the audition.

Dancers are encouraged to wear black dance attire that is firm fitting for the audition and bring a water bottle.

In allocating the bursaries the School will assess not only the individual applicant's special talents, but also the student's potential contribution to the profile of Dance within the School community.

NB: Acceptance of a Dance Bursary requires the successful candidate to commit to Dance as a subject in Year 10 in 2021.

Due to the nature of the application and audition process for a Dance Bursary, the School is not in a position to discuss the individual's performance from the Audition Day. We will, however, formally notify all applicants of their success or otherwise, as soon as possible, following the day.
