Australia Day Boarders’ Retreat – Tuesday, 26 January

It is important that all boarders arrive on the Boarder’s Travel Day, as Tuesday, 26 January is the Australia Day public holiday. TGS Boarding will use this day to hold our annual Boarders’ Retreat Day. Boarders will be travelling to Magnetic Island for the day to enjoy the day at the Picnic Bay area. The activities will be based around beach water play, ball games and scenic walks. Buses will depart from North Ward at 8:00am and will return at approximately 4:00pm. The boarding houses will be closed during this time. Therefore, it is important that boarders arrive well before the departure time.

Boarders will need to ensure they have the following items for the day;

- Hat
- Swimmers (including rashie/cover shirt)
- Spare set of clothes
- Water bottle
- Towel
- Thongs/sandals
- Sandshoes (bush walking)

Snacks and lunch will be provided on the day. However, boarders may choose to bring a small amount of pocket money for the purchase of their own snacks and treats from the local shops at Picnic Bay.

We would encourage you to read these handbooks with your children and become familiar with their contents. The Boarding Handbook has been edited and updated to include routines and expectations which have changed.

To help with the packing, we would like to remind parents that:

- Boarders need to be selective in what they bring as there is limited storage space. In particular boarders need to be circumspect regarding the volume of clothing they bring to School.
- All clothing must be labelled with **sewn on name tags** placed at the top of the garment in the centre back. Extra tags and a small sewing kit should be left with your child.
- Returning boarders are to bring their locks back to School.
- Boarders are to return to School with appropriate hair colour and style (Refer School Handbook) and boys are to be clean shaven.
