INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC ENROLMENT FORM 2021 | ANNANDALE CAMPUS

Fees: Fees are set annually based on the minimum recommended fee set by the Music Teachers Association of Queensland (MTAQ). Individual lessons will be at the rate of **\$44** per half hour lesson and group lessons (where available) will be at the rate of **\$22** per half hour lesson with a maximum of two students in a group. Fees are calculated at 16 lessons per Semester.

Billing and Withdrawal Policy: To cater for beginning students there will be no penalty for withdrawing within the first 4 weeks of Semester 1. (notify Junior School Music Co-ordinator in writing of withdrawal). Enrolment is then for the whole Semester (two terms) comprising of sixteen individual or sixteen group lessons and will be charged to School accounts early in Terms 1 and 3. There will be **no refunds** if a student withdraws from lessons during the Semester. Students who enrol for Semester 1 will automatically be re-enrolled for Semester 2. If a student does not wish to re-enrol for Semester 2, parents should forward written notice directly to the Junior School Music Co-ordinator at least two weeks prior to the end of Semester 1.

Lesson Timetable: Timetables will be emailed and are displayed on the Notice Board opposite the Arts Cottage. Lessons will rotate on a weekly basis so that no student regularly misses the same School lesson. Tutors will collect students from class at their lesson time. Requests for a special lesson time needs to be negotiated directly with the tutors.

Absence: **The instrumental teacher must be contacted directly prior to the commencement of the School day if a student will miss their lesson through illness.** Leaving a message at the front office or Arts Cottage is not sufficient. In the event of excursions, exams or family reasons, lessons can be rescheduled providing notice is given at least 24 hours in advance. **If this is not done, the lesson is forfeited.** Lessons missed through the absence of the teacher will be made up or not charged.

Lessons missed through forgetfulness will be forfeited.

Notes:

All Year 3 students will receive tuition on a string instrument (violin, viola, cello or double bass) for \$150 per Semester. These students do not need to present an enrolment form. Students will have a 30 minute group lesson once a week. Instruments and tutor books will be provided by the School for the year.
