

Boarding Residential Tutor (FEMALE)

Townsville Grammar School is one of the original Grammar Schools of Queensland. The Year 7-12 campus is located on the original site at North Ward. The School also operates two Junior School campuses, both offering Pre-Prep to Year 6, at Annandale and North Shore.

Townsville Grammar School is a co-educational, non-denominational School with a current enrolment of approximately 1250 students, including 125 boarders (7-12), of whom approximately 25 are international students.

As one of the eight original Grammar schools in Queensland, Townsville Grammar School was established in 1888 and has offered boarding since this time. The School has a long-standing reputation as the leading academic school in Northern Queensland, also offering the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme for Years 11 and 12.

Townsville Grammar School seeks to employ **Residential Tutors** (male and female) to join our dynamic boarding team. The commencement date is negotiable.

Our boarding facilities are located at our North Ward campus, and is home to approximately 130 boarders from diverse backgrounds including regional Queensland, international and indigenous, along with the 20 staff who care for them. It is a co-educational community, with well-appointed facilities on campus and walking distance to the Strand and Townsville CBD.

The School employs a large team of Residential Tutors who work to provide the very best pastoral and academic support for our boarders. This team is led by a dedicated Head of House and Director of Boarding.

Each Residential Tutor is expected to complete a roster of **one weekday night per week and the following morning wakeup**, along with an average of **four weekends per school term**. In addition, Residential Tutors will also assist with the arrival and departure periods of our boarding cohort. Duties would normally include; supervision during boarding routines, academic assistance during study sessions, providing transport using a school vehicle and co-ordinating small outings with allocated pastoral groups. The roster commitments do not exceed an average of 18 hours per week, averaged over the semester roster.

This position is a **'live in'** responsibility and as such accommodation forms part of the remuneration. A Residential Tutor is provided a private room, fully air-conditioned, along with shared common spaces such as kitchen, living and bathroom. Remuneration also includes term time meals, internet access, off
