Our extensive North Ward Co-Curricular Program for 2026 is set to begin in the coming weeks, with some activities commencing as early as Week 2. The Co-Curricular Expo will be held for students only on Friday, 30 January 2026, providing students with the opportunity to explore the many Co-Curricular options available at the School. Following the Expo, parents will be emailed details of the activities their child has selected, including program information and instructions for signing up via Parent Lounge.

Students are not restricted to the activities selected at the Expo and may choose to sign up for any activity available to their year level or age group, either before or after the Expo.

Once you have decided which Co-Curricular activity your child would like to participate in, please log in to Parent Lounge to complete the sign-up process. Most Activities will be available on Parent Lounge starting **Tuesday, 20 January**.

Important: Please ensure you click the green **Submit to School** button to finalise the registration. If an activity is showing as Pending, the sign-up process has not been completed. Once **Submit to School** has been selected, you will then be prompted to make payment if payment is required.

Some activities require students to participate in trials before registration is available. These activities will not appear in Parent Lounge until trials are completed and selected students have been notified. Activities will be listed under the Extra-Curricular tab. Please note that some programs have limited places and will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis.
