2024 Registrations	<p>Registrations for Grammar Club Netball are now officially open. Please see below the links to register for either the Junior competition (U12, U15, U18) or SetGO. Please ensure you register your daughter for the correct competition based on her birth date (regardless if they are playing up this year). We will then manually update this and add them to the correct team through Netball Connect after registration has been finalised. The age groups have also been listed below for your reference when registering.</p> <p>SetGO Students turning 7 – 10 years in 2024 U12 Students turning 11 or 12 years in 2024 U15 Students turning 13, 14, or 15 in 2024 U18 Students turning 16, 17, or 18 in 2024</p> <p>Please note that if your child is not turning 7 this year, they need to be registered for the Net program, which is run by the TCNAI. We need you – Call for Help.	<p>I am reaching out to ask for your assistance this year. Grammar Netball is in need for parents, guardians, or even older siblings, to be team managers and scorers for the 2024 Netball Season.</p> <p>As per the competition manual, it is a requirement each team provide a scorer for each game. This cannot be the coach, as the coach has other responsibilities and must sit on the team bench. All scoring will be done online via the Netball Connect app – very easy to set up and much easier than paper scoring! If we do not provide a scorer, the team and club will be penalised. If there is more than one parent able to help for each team, we can set up a rotation for scoring.</p> <p>We want our girls to have a fantastic season, which cannot happen without your support. If you are willing to assist us and your daughter's team this year, please email myself. I'm also more than happy to provide training and help set up the app.</p>
Duty of Care Player Waiver – Play Up Rule	<p>If your daughter has nominated to play up from their own age division, the TCNAI Duty of Care Player Waiver will need to be completed upon official registration. This has been added as part of the registration process through Netball Connect. If you have any issues during the registration process, please let us know. I have also attached a physical copy of the waiver to this email. This waiver allows players to play out of their designated age division, or players who are acting as fill-ins for other teams. It is a requirement that this form be completed, otherwise your child will not be allowed to play up or fill in for other teams. Please ensure to read through the information on the waiver before signing.</p>
