DIRECTOR OF MUSIC

Music is an integral part of life at Townsville Grammar School, both for the students who choose to study Music as a subject and perform in ensembles, and for the School community who enjoy our performances throughout the year.

The Music Program at Townsville Grammar School provides students from Prep to Year 12 with classroom, co-curricular and individual tuition opportunities. The program aims to develop foundational musical skills and musical literacy.

We strive to provide a positive program that fosters students' appreciation for Music and develops their confidence, self-esteem and creativity. Students who participate in our Ensembles and performance opportunities also benefit in learning to value and respect teamwork, punctuality and personal responsibility.

Townsville Grammar School stages a major production every two years, and it is a wonderful opportunity for students to be involved in a full-scale event which provides them with invaluable performance experience. In addition, there are numerous opportunities for our instrumental and vocal ensembles to perform at School and community events throughout the year.

We are very proud of our Music Program at Townsville Grammar School and endeavour to continue to grow the opportunities for our students to further enhance the quality of the musical life of our School community.

CURRICULUM MUSIC

Curriculum, or Classroom Music, is where students make and respond to Music through listening, performing and composing. Students learn about the elements of Music and gain an understanding of the range of styles and contexts. Curriculum Music is led by Specialist Teachers and Tutors.

In the Junior School, all students receive two half-hour Music classes each week. In Year 3, one of the Music classes involves participating in the Year 3 Strings Program.

- In the Middle School (Years 7-9), students in Years 7 and 8 participate in Classroom Music. Music is an elective subject available to students in Year 9.
- In the Senior School, Music is an elective subject for Years 10, 11 and 12. Townsville Grammar School also offers the advanced course, Music Extension for Year 12.
- Music is also offered for the International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma for Years 11 and 12 at Higher and Standard Levels.

INSTRUMENTAL & VOCAL TUITION

Ensemble membership is supported by Instrumental and Vocal Tuition. The School encourages students to learn instruments by integrating instrumental lessons into the School timetable. Experienced and qualified Music Tutors rotate lessons so that students do not miss too much of any other subject.
