OUR PREP LEARNING ENVIRONMENT

Student progress and achievement is directly linked to quality teaching. As the leading academic School in Northern Queensland, our learning approach begins with Prep.

Our carefully selected teachers focus on the individual learner, building positive relationships with students, supporting them and encouraging an environment where they strive for personal best.

Children enter Prep with a range of individual experiences, abilities and natural talents. Each child is encouraged to progress at a pace that is appropriate to their own development, without pressure.

In addition to being able to complete simple reading, writing and numeracy tasks (as per the Australian Curriculum), children will develop social and emotional skills, fine and gross motor skills, language and communication skills and a sense of independence throughout the Prep year.

When children have developed competencies in these areas, they are generally ready for Year 1
