CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Umbrella reserves the right to refuse entry to (or ask to leave) any person who does not comply with the following conditions. These conditions are intended for the safety of Umbrella visitors and personnel (including artists, staff and volunteers) and to maintain the safety of the premises, exhibitions and artwork.

COVID-19 SAFE ENTRY

While it is no longer a Queensland government mandate to self-isolate at home if you test positive to COVID-19 (since 14 October 2022), it is strongly recommended by Queensland Health and Umbrella. However, you must not enter:

- for at least 7 days after testing positive to COVID-19 if you are not wearing an appropriate mask for others' safety

Use the provided hand sanitiser to clean your hands thoroughly if needed, for instance after you sneeze or cough (and / or aim these into your elbow).

GENERAL ENTRY

You must follow the directions of Umbrella staff and volunteers at all times.

Umbrella may inspect all bags and personal belongings that visitors bring into this premises. When doing a bag check, we will not touch your bag or items in it however we may ask you to move items to help us see inside easily.

Facilities for cloaking belongings are not specifically available, however oversized items including suitcases, large umbrellas and prams present a trip hazard and risk to artworks, and should not be carried around the gallery space. Visitors should seek guidance from Umbrella staff or volunteers if they are unsure about placement or storage of a large bag or item.
